Faith-based Recovery and Discipleship

The efforts of our program are focused on the sobriety and wellbeing of our clients spiritually, emotionally, mentally and physically. This is a para-professional program with a strong *faith-based* philosophy of treatment.

Providing residence for those struggling with addictions and offering a structured setting with groups and classes is a very challenging endeavor. We recognize that there is a physical component to addictions with a possible neuro-chemical component. We are **not** qualified to address mental illness or the neuro-chemical components of addiction, but will provide, to the best of our ability, an atmosphere of spiritual nurture with boundaries and goal-setting opportunities.

We begin the road to recovery with a 5-week Pre-Induction program, focused on the 5 Components of Recovery: *Decision, Positive Peer Choice, Accountability, Boundaries, and Consistency*. Then we move the ladies on to the 5-month Induction phase. We accept ladies that will, to the best of their ability, commit to a minimum of 6 months, and highly recommend that all continue their road to recovery with an additional 10 months at one of our long-term programs for women (*Grace House, Evansville, IN; Teen Challenge Columbus, OH; Women at the Well, Athens, TN; and Western Michigan Teen Challenge, Muskegon, MI*).

We will not hold any student against their will after 5-weeks or anytime during their stay at *Priscilla's Place*. For many of these ladies, their recovery is a life or death decision. We highly recommend they continue their recovery and discipleship through *Teen Challenge* or another structured setting with high accountability!

We are not a *shame-based* program, but a *faith-based* ministry!
